




Litter prevention in Gävle city



- Provides operation and maintenance in streets parks and squares
- 2 000 wastebaskets in parks and in the streets (0,03 basket/pers)
- 20 recycling bins
- Sweep the streets and squares up till 365 days
- 2 000 000€/year for work to avoid littering (=28 €/year/pers)
- In charge of working against graffiti



Citizens can report littering and dumping to the municipality on the website

Litter measuring




Two weeks every year we measure litter in a survey from Keep Sweden Tidy.

The results are used to prevent littering in the future.










Waste Hierarcy

Mini sorting bins for children in their schoolyards.










